THE KEY TO THE CURE

Do you know what you want? Really want? Sometimes we want things that we do not need, which might even be harmful to us. Or are we blind because we have not dug deep enough into our heart and soul to see what we want?



Try keeping it simple---an act that requires confidence and humility. Bartimaeus follows this principle. He knows what he wants: his sight. The miraculous key that Jesus identified is faith. Do we have the courage to fling off our cloak? It is that simple----faith can help us find the way when we are blinded by confusion over what is important. Faith will save us.


