The invitation still stands

If the readings today were scenes in a movie, it would be quite dramatic. Keeping up with the characters and the content would be challenging. The first reading shows Elijah calling Elisha, where Elisha seems unsure of what to do. Elijah allows him to finish what he is doing first. Paul, in the second reading, is outlining the perpetual tension that Christians carry by being in this world but not of this world.



The gospel is where it all comes together. Jesus has his face set toward Jerusalem, knowing this is where his ministry will end with suffering and death. We are introduced to the would-be followers. On the surface, what they say seems to sound like excuses. Yet we know these are valid concerns. Jesus' response is designed to help them (and us) discern their commitment.

Discipleship is no small matter and will demand much from us. To follow Jesus, we must go beyond sentimentalism. Discipleship involves choice and commitment, which are born out of discernment. Discernment can only happen when there is authenticity.

What is Eucharistic Adoration? During Eucharistic Adoration, the faithful pray to Jesus Christ, who is present in the Eucharist. The Eucharist, also referred to as the Blessed Sacrament, is typically kept in a tabernacle at church.

While it is true that you can pray to God anywhere and that He is always within you, it is especially powerful to adore Jesus in the Eucharist. In the presence of the Eucharist, we pray to the power and sacrifice that it represents — the body of Jesus, who gave His life so that we may live.

It is His body, blood, soul and divinity that is really, truly, and substantially present in the Eucharist.

We adore and receive the Eucharist in communion at Mass, which is the most beautiful act of worship that we have as Catholics. We have Jesus truly present in all of the tabernacles around the world. We can continue to adore Him in the Eucharist after Mass in a quiet time of prayer and contemplation on Who we have just received. Being in the presence of the body, blood, soul and divinity of Jesus Christ gives spiritual strength and nourishment in a uniquely powerful way.
