

Kites and possibilities

A long, tight bundle of brightly colored paper, wrapping two narrow lengths of flexible wood, cost one shiny quarter 50 years ago. Carefully unroll it, place the slotted ends of the sticks into string loops glued into place on the outer seam of the flattened diamondshaped paper, then tie string where the sticks crossed and voila! You had a kite! Add some long strips of sheet from the rag bin for a tail, then off to the park!



The breeze caught the kites as we ran. Our spirits soared along with our paper flyers. Anything seemed possible. "We were all made to drink of one Spirit." Somewhere along our lives' path, fear joined us, dreams dimmed. Like those women and men gathered together so long ago, we also worry about what will become of us. Like them, we need to hear a sound "like a strong driving wind" and see, as they did, "tongues, as of fire." The Spirit touched them, breaking the bonds of their fear. It touches us too! As St. Paul says, "the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit." Hear him say, "Peace be with you." Dear Bothers and Sisters of Light of Christ Parish,

I would like to thank you all for your continued prayers, support, and contributions over the years. As you know, the parish has been doing a lot of renovations and maintenance the last several years, tuck-pointing, plastering, painting, lighting, electrical, heating, and air conditioning units totaling \$132,588.53.

We are now looking at our largest expense to date, repairing and replacing roofs at both of our locations. The roof on St. Alphonsus church is in need of repair and the St. Peters church roof and a rubber roof at St. Peters needs to be replaced. The estimated cost is approximately \$211,000.00, possibly more if there any underlying issues with water damage or dry rot. This is a large amount of money for our small parish, but we have also been saving as much as we can for these situations. Roofs are a top priority, essential to keeping our buildings structurally sound. The repairing and replacement is going to reduce our savings by almost half, but it is something that is needed for the longevity of the parish. Our savings accounts at TLC and Lansing total \$450,405.00.

Unfortunately, our buildings will always have issues that need to be taken care of, and that leads me to asking for your continued support. Just as everyone has experienced over the last few years the price increases in insurance, utilities, payroll, and taxes, the parish shares in that experience. The yearly expenses for the parish in 2015-2016 averaged just over \$158,000 and in 2022-2023 our average expenses are just over \$226,000, a The ability to put \$68,000 increase. money back into our savings is becoming harder every year. I would like to encourage everybody to prayerfully discern increasing your Sunday contributions, and only if you are able, as every little bit helps. My desire is that Light of Christ parish continues to be a light for others. Thank you for your consideration.
